







MY TIME DELICATESSEN

Sip a freshly squeezed juice or stock-up on organic fruit and vegetables in this Covent Garden style family run delicatessen, much-loved by the local community.





PALMERS GREEN IS AN IDEAL LOCATION FOR BOTH WORKING LIFE AND LEISURE.

The new C20 cycle route – a brand new, major infrastructure upgrade – connects Enfield Townwith Palmers Green and runs on both sides of Green Lanes and Aldermans Hill, making cycling around the neighbourhood safer and easier than ever before.
